CORRIGENDUM / AMENDMENT NOTICE

Sub: Amendment to e-Tender Notice Nos. 2026_WBEC_1038659_1 to 2026_WBEC_1038659_4 issued vide NIT No. ECSC/Sugar/2026/299 (Sugar) dated 18.08.2026, for supply of Sugar for Puja (Durga Puja, Kali Puja, Diwali & Chhat Puja) Festive Package, 2026, for distribution through the Public Distribution System in West Bengal — regarding.

Ref: NIT No. ECSC/Sugar/2026/299 (Sugar) dated 18.08.2026.

1. Reference is invited to the e-Tender Notice cited above vide which e-tenders, comprising Technical and Financial Bids, were invited from Sugar Mill/producers, Authorized distributors of Sugar Mills, Importers of Sugar, Exporters of Sugar and Civil Supply Corporations for supply of Sugar for Puja (Durga Puja, Kali Puja, Diwali & Chhat Puja) Festive Package, 2026, wherein the intending bidders were required to apply District-wise for 04 (four) Zones, namely Zone-A, Zone-B, Zone-C & Zone-D of West Bengal, for distribution through the Public Distribution System, vide e-Tender Notice Nos. 2026_WBEC_1038659_1 to 2026_WBEC_1038659_4.
2. With the approval of the Competent Authority, and for smooth and efficient processing of the tender, the following amendments are hereby made to the aforesaid NIT/e-Tender Document with immediate effect:

(i) Discontinuation of Zone-wise bidding and cancellation of e-Tender Notice Nos. 2026 WBEC 1038659 2 to 2026 WBEC 1038659 4

Instead of inviting bids Zone-wise under 04 (four) separate e-Tender Notices, intending bidders shall now be required to quote a single, consolidated bid covering all Districts of West Bengal taken together, against e-Tender Notice No. 2026_WBEC_1038659_1 only.

Accordingly, e-Tender Notice Nos. **2026_WBEC_1038659_2, 2026_WBEC_1038659_3 and 2026_WBEC_1038659_4** stand **CANCELLED** with immediate effect. Bidders shall submit their bids only against e-Tender Notice No. **2026_WBEC_1038659_1**, which shall now cover the entire State of West Bengal (all Districts).

The Bill of Quantities (BOQ) at Appendix-7 of the e-Tender Document has been amended accordingly to reflect a single, State-wide (all-Districts) quantity in place of the earlier Zone-wise quantities.

(ii) Amendment to Eligibility Criteria — Clause 1, sub-clause (A) & (B)

The existing sub-clause (A) under Clause 1 “Eligibility Criteria”, which reads:

“Producer/Miller of Sugar, Authorized distributor of sugar mills, Importers of sugar, Exporters of sugar and Civil Supply Corporations having past experience of sugar supply shall only be eligible for tendering bids for supplying sugar mentioned in the tender.”

is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Producer/Miller of Sugar, Authorized distributor of sugar mills, Importers of sugar, Exporters of sugar and Civil Supply Corporations having past experience of sugar supply in the State of West Bengal to State Government/ State Government PSU & Corporation etc. through PDS during any one of the last 03 (three) Financial Year shall only be eligible for tendering bids for supplying sugar mentioned in the tender.”

The existing sub-clause (B) under Clause 1 “Eligibility Criteria”, which reads:

“The Average Annual Turnover for the last 3 financial years of the intending bidder should not be less than Rs.8 (Eight) Crores per annum (F.Y.- 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25). The copy of annual turnover shall be duly certified by Chartered Accountant (C.A.) with UDIN. The bidder should have supplied the Sugar for each Zone or one Zone at least or any other PDS commodities to any Government Department/Corporation/PSU's etc. in any one time of the last 03 (three) Financial Year ending March '2025. “

is hereby amended to read as follows:

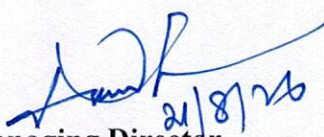
“The Average Annual Turnover for the last 3 financial years of the intending bidder should not be less than Rs.8 (Eight) Crores per annum (F.Y.- 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25). The copy of annual turnover shall be duly certified by Chartered Accountant (C.A.) with UDIN. The bidder must have supply credentials of value of Rs. 10 crore (Sugar only) in the State of West Bengal to State Government/ State Government PSU & Corporation etc. through PDS during any one of the last 03 (three) Financial Year. Necessary proof of Supply credentials from the Government/ PSU/ Corporation along with the value is required.”

All other sub-clauses of Clause 1 “Eligibility Criteria” shall remain unchanged.

(iii) Amendment to Earnest Money Deposit — Clause 2(A)

As the tender now covers the entire State of West Bengal in a single bid, the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) under Clause 2(A) “Earnest Money Deposit & Security Deposit” stands enhanced from **Rs. 8,00,000/- (Rupees Eight Lakhs only)** to **Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs only)**. Clause 2(A) is amended accordingly. All other terms relating to Security Deposit remain unchanged.

3. Save and except the amendments specifically made hereinabove, all other terms and conditions stipulated in the original NIT No. ECSC/Sugar/2026/299 (Sugar) dated 18.08.2026 and the e-Tender Document shall remain unchanged and binding on all intending bidders.
4. For the convenience and better understanding of the bidders, an Amended and Modified e-Tender Document, incorporating all the above amendments, is enclosed/uploaded along with this Corrigendum. All intending bidders are requested to take note of the amendments and submit their Technical and Financial Bids strictly in accordance with the amended e-Tender Document.
5. This Corrigendum shall form an integral part of the original NIT/e-Tender Document dated 18.08.2026 and shall be read in conjunction therewith.
6. All other terms and conditions, including the Date & Time Schedule of the e-Tender as notified in the original NIT, shall continue to remain in force unless separately amended/extended by this office. Intending bidders are advised to regularly visit the websites **<https://wbtenders.gov.in>** and **<https://www.wbecscegovernance.com>** for updates. WBECSC Ltd. shall not be held responsible if any bidder fails to take note of this amendment.

Document containing details of the E-Tender Notice inviting for Supply of Sugar for distribution as Festive Special Package through Public Distribution System during Puja Festival, 2026 in West Bengal.

West Bengal Essential Commodities Supply Corporation Limited (WBECSC Ltd.), West Bengal invites e-tender for the work detailed hereunder.

E-Tenders comprising of Technical and Financial bids are invited from Sugar Mill / producers, Authorized distributors of Sugar Mills, Importers of sugar, Exporters of sugar Civil Supply Corporations, having experience in Sugar operation for supply of sugar for **Puja (Durga puja, Kali Puja, Diwali & Chhat Puja) Festive Package, 2026** throughout West Bengal for distribution through Public Distribution System in West Bengal as per the terms and conditions stipulated by the WBECSC Ltd., West Bengal in its Tender Document and the agreement to be executed with the selected bidder(s). **Tentative quantity is Puja Festive Package, 2026 is 4618.497 M.T (Approx). The actual quantity may increase or decrease on the basis of actual indent received from the Food & Supplies Department.** Rate should be quoted for supply of sugar including GST, storing and handling (unloading and stacking) charges and transportation at designated godown points of bidder throughout West Bengal. Supplier shall deliver the allotted quantity of sugar to the vehicle placed by the M.R. distributor from his designated godown according to the lifting process and schedule, prepared by DCF&S/JDR of concerned district successfully. Supply order will be placed to selected supplier & the rates will remain valid during the entire validity period of the tender.

01. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

The following eligibility must be fulfilled without which the tender shall not be eligible for opening the financial bids.

- A. Producer/Miller of Sugar, Authorized distributor of sugar mills, Importers of sugar, Exporters of sugar and Civil Supply Corporations having past experience of sugar supply in the State of West Bengal to State Government / State Government PSU & Corporation etc. through PDS during any one of the last 03 (three) Financial Year shall only be eligible for tendering bids for supplying sugar mentioned in the tender.
- B. The Average Annual Turnover for the last 3 financial years of the intending bidder should not be less than Rs.8 (Eight) Crores per annum (F.Y.- 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25). The copy of annual turnover shall be duly certified by Chartered Accountant (C.A.) with UDIN. The bidder must have supply credentials of value of Rs. 10 crore (Sugar only) in the State of West Bengal to State Government / State Government PSU & Corporation etc. through PDS during any one of the last 03 (three) Financial Year. Necessary proof of Supply credentials from the Government / PSU / Corporation along with the value is required.
- C. The Bidders shall have to submit an undertaking as per **Annexure-C** in regard to adequate logistics set up. The selected supplier/suppliers shall have to store in godown only Sugar as per the supply order of WBECSC Ltd. and no other Sugar/commodity shall be allowed to be store in the designated godown. The selected supplier must provide proof of availability of 21 Sugar godowns one in **each of the 21 districts** (except Kalimpong District, **as per Annexure-A** across West Bengal. For Kolkata separate designated godown may be located in and around District H.Q., South 24 Pgs. The hiring Agreement/owner's consent document copy of the said owned/hired godown must be submitted along with the Tender Document.
- D. *Producer of Sugar, Authorized distributors of sugar mills, Importers of sugar, Exporters of sugar or Civil Supply Corporations who are Major defaulters in supplying PDS sugar at any time during last five years and/or blacklisted by the Government(s)/ Govt. Undertaking(s) / State Procurement Agencies are not entitled to participate in the tender. The bidder(s) is to submit self declaration/ certificate from competent authority into the matter. Government reserves right to verify the said declaration/ certificate into the matter.*
- E. Bidders are expected to observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of this Contract. In pursuit of this policy, WBECSC Ltd. will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the Bidder being considered for award has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the Contract.

For the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below are defined as follows:

- “corrupt practice” means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action in the procurement process or in Contract execution;
- “fraudulent practice” means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence the procurement process;
- “Collusive practice” means designs to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels to deprive WBECSC Ltd.of the benefits of competition.

02. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT & SECURITY DEPOSIT:-

Earnest Money Deposit

- A. The Bidders should furnish an Earnest Money of Rs 10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten lakhs Only) that should be deposited online e-Tender portal by 11.09.26 at 12.00 noon. Tender received without Earnest Money shall be summarily rejected. In case of unsuccessful bidders, the Earnest Money will be refunded.
- B. The amount remitted towards Earnest Money is liable to be forfeited in case the Bidders resign from his/their offer after submission of tender or after acceptance of offer by WBECSC Ltd. In such a situation the Tender committee of WBECSC Ltd., subject to approval of the competent authority, will be at liberty to negotiate rates with L-2 and or L-3 for supplying sugar at the rate of L-1 and issue offer letter.
- C. The Earnest Money shall not carry any interest.

Security Deposit

The EMD of successful bidder will be converted into Security Deposit and the total Security Deposit (inclusive of EMD) will be **10%** of the accepted value of Tender. The balance amount of security deposit will be taken from successful bidder(s) in the form of Bank Guarantee (B.G). The B.G has to be submitted by the successful bidder within 7(Seven) days from the date of acceptance of Offer. If the successful bidder fails to furnish security deposit within the time specified, the EMD shall stand forfeited, besides recovery of consequential losses, if any, sustained by the Corporation apart from cancellation of award of supply contract and blacklisting of the bidder. The Security Deposit/Earnest Money Deposit will not bear any interest. Security Deposit will be refunded after successful completion of the order.

03. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS:

- A. **Registration of Bidder:** Bidders willing to take part in the process of e-Tendering will have to be enrolled & registered with the Government e-Procurement system; through logging on to <https://wbtenders.gov.in> The contractor is to click on the link for e-Tendering site as given on the web portal.
- B. **Digital Signature certificate (DSC):** Each Bidder is required to obtain a Class-III Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) for submission of tenders from the approved service provider of the National Informatics Centre (NIC) on payment of requisite amount.
- C. **Mode of collection of Tender Documents:** The Bidders can search & download NIT & Tender Document(s) electronically from computer once he logs on to the website mentioned in Clause '05 A' using the Digital Signature Certificate. This is the only mode of collection of Tender Documents.

04. PRE BID MEETING:

Prospective bidders may attend a Pre-bid Meeting which will be held on 24.08.26 at 2.00 P.M in WBECSC Ltd. at 11/A Mirza Ghalib Street, Kolkata 700 087 for clearing the doubt (s) if any towards filling up e-tender documents and online submission of required documents.

05. BID SUBMISSION PROCEDURE:-

- A. Intending bidder may download the Tender Documents from the website <https://wbtenders.gov.in> directly with the help of Digital Signature Certificate.
- a) All appendices attached with this Tender Document should be duly filled in with signature in all pages and are mandatory for considering any offer as valid.
 - b) The Tender Document downloaded from the website specified above should be signed in each and every page as token of having accepted all the Tender conditions.
 - c) The persons (s) signing the tender shall state the capacity under which he/they is /are signing the tender.
 - d) The Bidders must be in a position to quote for supply in accordance with the requirement stated in point 02 (Eligibility Criteria) and Schedule-1. All the enclosures to this Tender Document should be duly filled in, digitally signed and uploaded in the website wbtenders.gov.in
 - e) Bidders must complete the Questionnaire on standard proforma (appendix-2) enclosed with this Tender Document.
 - f) Stipulated conditions in the tender are for Sugar Miller, Authorized distributors of sugar producers, Importers of Sugar, Exporters of sugar and Civil Supply Corporations with specific years of distribution experience. The claim of the Bidders regarding this/their eligibility should be supported by documents for such claim to the satisfaction of WBECSC Ltd. Such documentary evidences needs to be signed, scanned and uploaded in the website wbtenders.gov.in.
 - g) The Tender Document downloaded from the website specified above should be signed in each and every page as token of having accepted all the Tender conditions.
 - h) The persons (s) signing the tender shall state the capacity under which he/they is /are signing the tender.
- B. **Amendment of bidding documents:** WBECSC Ltd. may at its sole discretion amend the bidding documents at any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids. However in case of such amendment, the Bid submission date may be extended at the discretion of WBECSC Ltd.. Any amendments/corrigendum, as and when required, will be uploaded only on the websites <http://wbtenders.gov.in> & <https://www.wbecscgovernance.com>. Interested bidder should regularly visit these websites for any updates. WBECSC Ltd. is not liable in case the bidder(s) fail to make note of such amendments.

(A) Technical Proposal: Containing Statutory cover and Non statutory Cover.

The Cover shall contain the following documents:

1. The entire tender document excluding Appendix – 7 (which is meant for quoting the rate) should be downloaded properly, physically signed, scanned and uploaded.
2. In case of an importer or exporter of sugar, documents pertaining to the authority from the Govt. of India such as export / import license etc. In case of Authorized distributors of Sugar Producers appointment letter as authorized distributor of sugar producer. In case of sugar producer, proof as to sugar producer.

3. Certificate/Letter as per Annexure-B and Self Declaration where necessary.
4. The Bidders shall have to submit the self declaration regarding their capability of handling, storing, transportation & manpower for doing the job with the list of godowns and copy of documents in favour of owned/hired godowns (agreement copy).
5. **List of godowns/store house as per Annexure A along with copy of ownership/ hiring agreement/owner's consent document for the entire validity period of tender. Government reserves right to verify godowns.**
6. An undertaking in the Annexed Proforma (**Annexure-C**) duly signed and sealed to be submitted to the effect that the ownership/ hiring agreement in r/o **godowns/store house** as mentioned in **Annexure A** will be submitted on or before the date of the submission of Bank Guarantee (BG), if he becomes the L1 bidder.
7. Valid and up-to date trade license similar in nature/of manufacturer license/ license or documents of approval from Govt. of India from import/export as applicable.
8. Scanned copy of duly filled in Annexure "B"
9. Scanned copy of Permanent Account Number (PAN).
10. Scanned copy of Income Tax return/Proof of Income Tax Deposit [Current].
11. Scanned copy of latest GSTR-3B return. Latest P.Tax Certificate/ Challan if applicable.Valid FSSAI license.
12. Documents pertaining to experience of the Bidder in work of similar nature. (as stated in eligibility criteria)
13. Documents pertaining to annual turnover of last 3 consecutive years of the Bidder.(as stated in eligibility criteria)

(B) Financial Proposal:-

- a. The Financial Bid should contain rate for supply of sugar at all storing points of the bidders. Rate should be quoted in the BOQ as specified in Appendix – 7. The Appendix-7 should be downloaded and duly filled in and uploaded in the specified folder.
- b. The rate (inclusive of all viz. price of sugar, GST, handling, storage and transportation) should be quoted per M.T. in Appendix – 7. Bidders should quote the rate per M.T. in INR and it would be valid for **150 days** from the date of the agreement executed thereafter.
- c. Rates to be quoted in the separate BOQ provided herewith at Appendix-7.
- d. Any composite bid indicating rates submitted openly in the Technical Bid is liable to be cancelled while evaluating the Technical Bid.
- e. A Comparative Statement shall be prepared for evaluation of the Financial Bid. Normally the successful Bidder will be accepted on L1 basis (Lowest Price basis) after following the procedures prescribed in the tender. In case the Lowest Tender needs to be rejected, the reasons shall be recorded in writing.
- f. The bidder who has submitted the lowest responsive rate as per the format provided shall be termed as the L1 bidder. Award of the contract will be given to the bidder who will submit lowest responsive rate.
- g. Successful bidder will have to submit letter of acceptance within 7 days from the date of receipt of Offer Letter.
- h. Work Contract shall be awarded on acceptance of rates received from the successful bidders.

7. OPENING OF TENDER:-

A. Opening of Technical Bid

- a. Members of the Tender Evaluation Committee will open the Technical Bid in the chamber of the Chairman of the Tender Committee, WBECSC Ltd., 11 A Mirza Ghalib Street, Kolkata 700087 on scheduled date and time as specified in Date and Time schedule of the Tender.
- b. The EMD submitted shall be evaluated first.
- c. Technical bids of EMD-qualified bidders shall be opened thereafter and evaluated with reference to the parameters prescribed in the e- tender documents.

- d. After evaluation, the names of technically qualified bidders will be uploaded in e-Tender portal.

B. Opening of Financial Bid

- a. The Financial Bid of ONLY those Bidders, who qualify in the Technical Bid after proper evaluation by the Tender committee of WBECSC Ltd., will be opened.
- b. Financial Bid shall be opened (online) {at the date and time which will be informed after finalization and uploading list of technically qualified bidder} of those bidders only who have been found technically qualified after proper evaluation by the Tender committee of WBECSC Ltd. Financial Bids of Bidders failing to comply with the specifications of Technical Bid shall NOT BE TAKEN INTO CONSIDERATION.
- c. The decision of the Tender committee of WBECSC Ltd. will be final and absolute in this respect.
- d. Bidders or Authorized representatives of the bidders may remain present at the time of opening of both Technical Bid and Financial Bid on the scheduled date and time as specified in Date and Time schedule of the Tender.

8. AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT OR REJECT THE TENDER:-

- A. The Tender committee of WBECSC Ltd. reserves the right to accept or reject any/all tenders without assigning any reason thereof and the same cannot be questioned at any time whatsoever.
- B. WBECSC Ltd. also reserves the right to accept one or more tenders for supply of Sugar, if the Corporation is of the opinion that Supply cannot be covered by a single supplier.
- C. WBECSC Ltd. reserves the exclusive right to increase/decrease or split the quantity of the tender. No Bidder is entitled to withdraw his offer once the tender is filed.
- D. WBECSC Ltd. reserves the right to relax or waive or amend any of the tender conditions as and when necessary.
- E. Decision of The Tender committee of WBECSC Ltd. shall be final in regard to evaluation of the documentary evidences and other claims with regard to the eligibility of the Bidder.
- F. Before issuance of the WORK ORDER, the tender inviting authority may verify the credential and other documents of the successful Bidders, if deemed necessary, apart from the godown-reports. After verification, if it is found that, the documents submitted by the said Bidders(s) are either false or fabricated, the tender is liable to be rejected and the Earnest Money is liable to be forfeited. The Corporation reserves the right to award parallel supply order without giving any notice to the supplier or terminate awarded supply order at any time by giving 7(Seven) days notice, if the service of the supplier/suppliers are found unsatisfactory. For any further clarification, prospective bidders may contact at WBECSC Ltd., 11 A Mirza Ghalib Street, Kolkata 700 087, during working hours in any working day with the downloaded copy of the tender document.

9. VALIDITY OF OFFER:-

- A. The offers made by the Bidders shall be valid for 150 days. The Bidders should not quote any other date for the validity of the offer. Bidders quoting any other validity date are liable to be summarily rejected.
- B. The rate offered by the bidder and once accepted by the Corporation shall be final and this rate shall continue till the offer ceases to be valid. Corporation is not responsible for any fluctuation of prices either in International Market or Domestic Market and no request or representation for revision of rate will be entertained.
- C. However, rates accepted shall not be a guarantee to place supply orders.

10. FALL CLAUSE:-

The price charged for the sugar supply under the contract by the successful bidder/bidders shall in no event exceed the lowest price at which the successful bidder sells the sugar of identical description to any other person in the state during the period of contract.

- A. If at any time, during the said period of rate contract in the state of West Bengal the Contractor reduces the sale price of such sugar or sells such sugar to any other person at a price lower than the price chargeable under the contract, he shall forthwith notify such reduction of sale price and the sugar supplied after the date of coming into force of such reduction of sale price shall stand correspondingly reduced. The successful bidder shall furnish certificate in the manner required by the Corporation to the effect that the provision of the clause has been duly complied with respect to supplies made or billed for up to the date of certification.
- B. The successful bidder(s) shall endorse a certificate on each bill to the effect that the price condition referred to the above has been maintained satisfactorily.

11. QUALITY ASSURANCE:-

The bidder shall have to ensure the quality of sugar supplied in 50 kg bags which strictly conforms to the ISS specification and FSSAI standards as per specification mentioned in Schedule-1. In the event of any of the samples taken from the stock of sugar on arrival at a designated godown is found to be substandard on testing, the concerned supplier will be wholly responsible for that. Further, the supplier will have to immediately replace the entire stock of substandard sugar at their own cost.

Further, in the event of any of the sugar samples out of built up stock in any godown found sub-standard on testing, in addition to replacement of substandard stock, penalty shall be imposed to the extent of sugar stock of that particular lot / batch in the following manner.

- 1st time failure of sample (sub-standard): 10% of cost of sugar stock of that godown.
- In case of sample of sugar found to be substandard on subsequent occasion in the same godown: 10% of cost of sugar stock and apart from imposition of such penalty, the agreement with the supplier concerned shall immediately be terminated.

12. TESTING OF SUGAR:-

- A. Selected Bidder(s) will have to make available sample of sugar in 05 (Five) sealed plastic jars of 1 K.G. each with appropriate signature and seal of the bidder on it which will be analyzed from Government / Govt. approved/ recognized laboratory .Laboratory testing charges for the same shall be deducted from the earnest money deposited by the bidder.
- B. The testing of sugar will be done through the surveyor on pre-delivery at random sampling from the godown point of the supplier. A team of Quality Control Staff of Food & Supplies Department may also inspect the storage godowns anywhere in West Bengal and the supplier will be responsible for quality and grade supply of the sugar at all point of sale. If any deviation is found from the specified quality standard as per schedule 1, in addition to the action to be taken as per quality assurance clause, the Security Deposit shall stand forfeited besides recovery of consequential losses, if any, sustained by the Corporation and blacklisting of the bidder.

13. MODE OF SUPPLY:-

WBECSC Ltd. shall issue a Dispatch/Delivery Schedule to the selected Bidder/s for supply of sugar at the respective storing points of the supplier specified herein above.

14. DURATION OF SUPPLY:-

For supply of sugar, work order may be issued Godown/ District-wise for one time during Puja Festive 2026. The supply should commence within 7 (Seven) days after the communication of order for supply of sugar and the entire supply should be completed within 15 (fifteen) days from the issue of supply order. In case of any deliberate delay in delivering the stock, the Corporation may impose penalty as per Para No17 on “Penalty on Default / Extension of time” and quality assurance of the tender conditions for delayed supply.

15. OTHER TERMS & CONDITIONS:-

- A. Bidders must meet the commodity standard as per specification in Schedule-1.
- B. WBECSC Ltd. reserves the right to get the manufacturing/packaging capacity of the Bidders re-verified through inspecting agencies, irrespective of their registration status.
- C. If a Major defaulter/ blacklisted firm files tender under a “benami” name, the tender shall stand rejected apart from forfeiture of EMD furnished.
- D. The Bidder is to submit copies of Annual Accounts(P/L accounts, Balance Sheet etc) for the last three financial years (F.Y.- 2022-23, to F.Y.- 2024-25), duly audited by a Chartered Accountant with UDIN and duly certified by the Chartered Accountant with UDIN (as per Appendix-3)and also Annual Turnover Report for the F.Y.- 2022-23, to F.Y.- 2024-25.
- E. The Bidder is to submit copies of Income Tax Statement/ Income Tax Return (Assessment Year-2023-24 to Assessment Year -2025-26) for last three financial years, duly attested by the Chartered Accountant/ Income Tax Officer.

- F. At the time of submitting Tender Scanned copy of Annexure-B, in case of Producer/Miller of Sugar, Scanned copy of the Document(s) from Govt. of India in case of Importer /exporter of sugar & Scanned copy of Self declaration supported with Annexure-B in case of Authorized distributors of Sugar Producer shall have to be uploaded. **The letter as per Annexure-B must be submitted along with the tender document in the said format only and no other format/agreement will be accepted.**
- G. The bidder should produce documentary evidence along with the tender in support of their eligibility criteria (eg. Manufacturing Licence / Trade Licence, Export /import license / authority and documents to prove that he has imported / exported sugar in case of the importer / exporter. The selected supplier must provide proof of availability of sugar godowns in **each of the godowns / storing points** as per Annexure-A across West Bengal.
- H. The Bidders shall have to submit the self declaration regarding their capability of handling, storing, transportation & manpower for doing the job.
- I. In case in future if the original documents uploaded by the bidders is found to be forged, tampered or false, then as a penalty the EMD/SD of the said bidders would be forfeited and a strict legal action would be taken against such bidder.
- J. The supplier/ suppliers shall submit a list of contact personnel along with the tender document.
- K. Tenders specifying additional conditions or proposing modifications to the tender conditions will be treated as Conditional Tenders and Conditional tender will not be accepted even on deposit of valid Earnest Money.
- L. Inspection of the godowns will be made by the Corporation and supply order will be given to the L1 bidder on the basis of satisfactory reports only. If it is found that a godown is not fit for storing sugar, Corporation is not liable to place supply order.
- M. The tenders of those who do not qualify the eligibility criteria shall be rejected at any time during detailed scrutiny and evaluation stage.
- N. The decision of Tender committee of WBECSC Ltd. shall be final in regard to evaluation of the documentary evidences and other claims with regard to the eligibility of the Bidder.
- O. The Tender committee of WBECSC Ltd. reserves the right to reject any/all tenders without assigning any reason thereof and the same cannot be questioned at any time whatsoever.
- P. The G.O. 2320-F(Y) dated- 07.06.2022 may be followed, if situation arises, and in case of a tie bid, G.O. 2320-F(Y) dated- 07.06.2022, to be followed.
- Q. The bidder should submit at least one of past performance in the form of experience certificate/supply order of Sugar or any other PDS commodities to any Government Department/Corporation/PSU's.
- R. Any other transit loss, abnormal loss etc., if arises, should be borne by bidder exclusively.

16. PAYMENT:-

- A. Supplier is to submit SINGLE BILL against each supply order/work order after completion of delivery at the designated storing points in the districts.
- B. Payment will be released to the supplier on submission of bills only after stocks have been lifted by the distributor/ wholesalers from their designated storing points. After qualifying the Quality Test, the payment shall be made for the net weight of sugar supplied excluding packing material.
- C. No part payment/Ad-hoc payment will be entertained.
- D. Payment will be made by means of NEFT / RTGS in favour of the supplier.
- E. Tax invoice(s) needs to be issued by the supplier for raising claim under the contract showing separately the tax charged in accordance with the provisions of GST Act, 2017”.
- F. No interest payment on outstanding bills will be entertained at any point of time.
- G. WBECSC Ltd.also reserves the right to recover such amount which might have been detected over paid to the supplier subsequently.

17. PENALTY ON DEFAULT & EXTENTION OF TIME:-

The entire ordered quantity should be supplied within the stipulated time. WBECSC Ltd. reserves the right to cancel the orders for the unsupplied quantity and such supplier is liable and responsible to make good the financial loss sustained by WBECSC Ltd. For failure to keep up the supply schedule fixed for supply as per **Para 14** on Duration of Supply, a penalty of Rs. 25/- per day per M.T. for the defaulted quantity shall be levied for each day of delay in supply or for short supply, subject to maximum of Rs. 500/- per M.T. Should the supplier fail to deliver the stock thereafter, WBECSC Ltd.may forfeit full or part of the EMD/Security Deposit, besides penalty including black listing of the supplier. WBECSC Ltd.also reserves the right to grant extension of time with/without penalty based on the past performance of the supplier or may take action to terminate the contract should the supplier be found a habitual defaulter.

18. AGREEMENT:-

The Bidders shall execute an Agreement with WBECSC Ltd. in the prescribed form, on a stamp paper of value as per law, within seven (7) working days from the date of receipt of communication of acceptance of the tender. In the event of failure to execute the agreement, the Earnest Money shall be forfeited without prejudice for the other remedies available to the WBECSC Ltd. under the Contract Act and applicable law. In addition, the Bidders will be treated as having committed Breach of Contract and will be liable to pay damages to the Corporation for such breach of contract. Any action for debarment/blacklisting shall be taken only in accordance with the applicable rules and after following the prescribed procedure and principal of natural justice. WBECSC Ltd. reserves the right to collect the any actual loss or additional expenditure incurred due to such default by the Corporation, on account of re-tender, from the Bidders and the latter

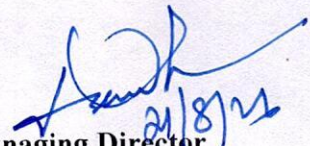
19. JURISDICTION :-

Any dispute, difference or claim arising out of or in connection with this Tender Document, the bidding process, the Letter of Acceptance, or the resultant Contract shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent Courts at Kolkata, West Bengal.

The bidder/contractor shall be deemed to have accepted the jurisdiction of the said Courts by participating in the Tender Process and/or entering into the contract.

20. ARBITRATION :-

- i. Any or all disputes, and/or differences and claims arising out of the performance of the Supply Contract or construction, interpretation or application of any terms and conditions or any matter or thing in any way connected with or in connection with or arising out of the Supply Contract, or the rights, duties or liabilities of any Party under the Supply Contract, at any time, whether relating to law or fact both, shall at first be attempted to be resolved between WBECS Ltd. and the Supplier amicably through mutual discussion and negotiation. Either of the Parties shall be entitled to give a notice of clear 30 (thirty) days of such dispute to the other Party requesting for bi-partite discussion between them. Upon receiving such notice, the other Party shall forth with enter into discussions with the Party issuing the said notice in an attempt to resolve such dispute, within a period of 45(forty five) days from the date of issuance of such notice;
- ii. In the event any dispute between the Parties cannot be amicably settled within the said period of 45(forty five) days as specified above, the dispute shall be referred to and finally resolved by Arbitration in accordance to the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and any amendments thereof.
- iii. The arbitration shall be conducted by a sole arbitrator to be appointed by the Managing Director, WBECS Ltd. .
- iv. The seat and venue of the Arbitration shall be at Kolkata and the Arbitration shall be conducted in English language. The Arbitration Award so passed shall be final and binding on the Parties.
