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(1) Introduction

The West Bengal Essential Commodities Supply Corporation Limited (WBECSC Ltd.) is a Government of West Bengal undertaking within the meaning of Companies Act 1956 which was incorporated by Government of West Bengal and is an autonomous body directly under the administrative control of Food & Supplies Department, dealing with diverse essential commodities including its procurement, storage and distribution.

WBECSC Ltd. has been entrusted by Food & Supplies department, Govt. of West Bengal Vide memo No.3178-FS/Sectt./4p-20/2017 dated-18.10.2017 to act as the State Procuring Agency for procurement of Jute bales through Jute Commission of India and subsequent transportation and storage of such procured Jute Bgas at designated godowns of different districts across the state of West Bengal for use in packing of Custom Milled Rice(CMR) for the respective KMSs.

To accomplish such entrusted job of Jute Bag procurement operation, WBECSC Ltd places indent through Jute Smart portal of JCO for procurement of Jute Bags through the office of JCO based on the district wise requirement/allotment breakup of Jute Bags shared from the Food & Supplies department. Subsequently, on receiving of requisite fund from WBECSC through ESCROW account, JCO issues PCSO mentioning Jute Mill wise allotment of Jute Bags meant for the delivery to the corresponding designated district jute godowns. On issuance of such PCSO, transportation work order is issued to the empanelled Transport Contractor of WBECSC for loading of Jute bags from concerned jute mill points and delivery of the same at designated district Jute godowns/delivery point within stipulated time. Since inception, WBECSC Ltd is doing transportation of Jute Bags at designated godown across West Bengal successfully through expert and professional transport agency till date.

However the tenure of engagement of the existing Transport Contractor for such Jute Bag procurement operation is going to expire very shortly. As such the Authority in WBECSC desires to select new Transport contractor for the said purpose afresh for **02(two) years tenure**. For this purpose this E-Tender is invited for selection of eligible Transport Contractor for Jute Bag operation under WBECSC.

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(2) Instruction to Bidders and Eligibility Criteria

2.1 The Tender document is available and downloadable on the following website www.wbtenders.gov.in

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2.2 Completeness of bids

Bidders are advised to study all instructions, forms, terms, requirements, and other information in the E-Tender document carefully. Submission of bid shall be deemed to have done after careful study and examination of the E-Tender document with full understanding of its implications. The response to this E-Tender should be full and complete in all respects. Failure to furnish the information required mentioned in the E-Tender documents or submission of a proposal not substantially responsive to the E-Tender documents in every respect will be at the bidder's risk and may result in rejection of its proposal. The E-Tender document is not transferable to any other bidder.

2.3 Pre Bid Meeting and clarification :

Prospective bidders in the tender may attend a Pre-Bid Meeting which will be held on 29/01/2024 at 03:00 P.M. at Head Office of WBECSC Ltd. at 11-A, Mirza Ghalib Street, Kolkata 700 087 for any type of clarification regarding this E-Tender.

2.4) Deposition Of Earnest Money & Security Deposit

- a) Prospective bidders shall have to deposit an Earnest Money of Rs. 10, 00,000/- (Rupees Ten lacs only) through online E-Tender Portal. The EMD will not carry any interest.
- b) The deposited Earnest Money will not carry any interest. The Earnest money will be retained till issue of work order to the selected Transport Contractor(s). Thereafter, Earnest Money of Unsuccessful Bidders shall be refunded. Earnest Money of selected Transport Contractor(s) shall be refunded after receiving Security Deposit to be supported by the original Money Receipt.
- c) EMD may be forfeited:
 - If the selected bidder fails to deposit Security Deposit within stipulated period. i)
 - If a bidder withdraws its bid during the period of bid validity. ii)
 - If the selected bidder fails to accept the Letter of Intent. iii)
 - If a bidder breaches the Terms and Condition of this tender. iv)

d) Refund of EMD :

The EMD of all bidders save and except L1 shall be refunded automatically by the portal.

e) The selected Transport Contractor(s) should furnish a Security Deposit of 10 % of estimated contract value (i.e. Rs. 2,68,96,000 for 02 years), within a week from the date of acceptance of his tender, through RTGS/NEFT as per bank details mentioned in Page-1, the value of Security deposit will be mentioned in the Engagement letter and any prayer for conversion of previously deposited security deposit shall not be entertained. <u>The Security Deposit will not carry any interest</u>.

f) Bid Validity

The bid must be valid for 180 days from the last date of submission of the bid. However the WBECSC may extend this period subject to bidder's acceptance. The bidder should not quote any other date for the validity of the offer. Tenders quoting any other validity date are liable to be summarily rejected.

G) Interpretation of the clauses in the tender documents:

In case of any ambiguity in the interpretation of any of the clauses in tender documents, WBECSC's interpretations of the clauses shall be final and binding on the bidder. The decision taken by the WBECSC in the process of tender evaluation will be full and final.

h) Submission Of Tender:

i) All appendices, attached with this Tender Document should be duly filled in and uploaded with digital signature in all pages. This is mandatory for considering any offer as valid.

ii) Bidder must complete the questionnaires on standard proforma enclosed (Appendix-1 to
4) with this Tender Document. Bidders who are willing to take part in the process of etendering will have to be enrolled & registered with the Government e-

Procurement system through logging into the website

www.<u>wbtenders.gov.in</u> and to click on the link for e-tendering site as given on the web portal.

iii) Each participant, for submission of tender, is required to obtain a Class-III Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) from the approved service provider of the National Information Centre (NIC) on payment of requisite amount, the details of which are available at the Website Guidelines to the Bidder. DSC is given as a USB e-Token iv) Bidders can download Notice Inviting e-Tender (NIT) & Tender Documents by logging into the website mentioned above using the Digital Signature Certificate.
 This is the only mode of collection of Tender Documents.

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- v) Tenders are to be submitted online in the website in the specified folders one for Technical Details & the other for Financial Bid, before the prescribed date & time (Appendix-6)using the Digital Signature Certificate (DSC).
- vi) All appendices attached with this Tender Document *except Appendix-5 & 6* should be duly filled in with signature in all pages and are mandatory for considering any offer as valid.
- vii) The tenders of those who do not qualify the eligibility criteria shall be rejected at any time during detailed scrutiny and evaluation stage, to be done later on.
- viii) The financial rate of the bidder is to be submitted online only in the prescribed format (Appendix-5) of Commercial bid. Mention of rate anywhere else in the tender document shall make it liable to be rejected.
- Tender form downloaded in the name of the prospective bidder / firm alone should be used, otherwise it will be rejected.
- x) The Financial bids of only Technically Qualified Bidders shall be opened.

- 4) Self declaration regarding fleet of trucks owned by the firm/ company/organization & their carrying capacity (in M.T.) as well, in official letter head pad duly signed & stamped by the person eligible to do so.
- 5) Transporter should submit 05 number of truck documents which prove that the vehicles are roadworthy (Insurance certificate, Tax Certificate, Pollution certificate, Fitness certificate, etc).
- 6) Photocopy of Trade License issued in the name of Proprietorship concern, partnership firm and/or company as the case may be.
- 7) Photocopy of Certificate of Professional Tax with latest challan.
- 8) Self declaration cum undertaking regarding taking utmost care while transporting the Jute Bales from originating to destination points, & to bear the consequential losses arising out of any damage during transportation, in the official letter head pad, duly signed & Stamped, by the person eligible to do so.

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(3) Project overview and Scope of Work

- 1) WBECSC Ltd places indent through Jute Smart portal of JCO for procurement of Jute Bags through the office of JCO based on the district wise requirement/allotment breakup of Jute Bags shared from the Food & Supplies department. Subsequently, on receiving of requisite fund from WBECSC through ESCROW account, JCO issues PCSO mentioning Jute Mill wise allotment of Jute Bags meant for the delivery to the corresponding designated district jute godowns. On issuance of such PCSO, transportation work order is issued to the empanelled Transport Contractor of WBECSC for loading of Jute bags from concerned jute mill points and delivery of the same at designated district Jute godowns/delivery point within stipulated time.
- 2) The Transport Contractor or his authorized representative shall issue requisite road challan / consignment note in triplicate at the time of loading of Jute bags in truck at Jute Mill point and for transportation of the loaded Jute Bales. The Transport Contractor or his authorized representative shall satisfy himself as to the number of bales and weight of Jute Bags loaded on the truck before preparation of the road challan as well before commencement of the journey.
- 3) The Transport Contractor shall have to place required no. of trucks with valid documents as per Motor Vehicles Acts and other relevant acts or rules in vogue, having carrying capacity of at least 50 bales of Jute Bags per truck at the loading points of concerned Jute Mills on receiving the work order for transportation from the Authority of WBECSC.
- 4) The Transport Contractor Shall have to issue road challans mentioning all relevant details of quantity of Jute bags loaded in the trucks, truck number, name and mobile number of the driver, route to be followed, date of loading, loading & unloading points so as to make the driver enable handing over the said road-challans to the authorized representative of WBECSC Ltd at the unloading points of designated district Jute godowns and get it counter signed after delivery of the allotted consignment. E-Way bill should be generated by the transporter before transportation of Jute Bags.
- 5) The transport Contractor should send daily report on quantity of jute bales transportation to the Authority of WBECSC as per the format as will be shared from time to time.
- 6) In the event of any diversion of route from the route originally specified for any reason whatsoever beyond the control of the Transport Contractor, the Transport Contractor shall seek permission from the WBECSC Ltd. Such permission must be obtained in writing, stating therein reasons for such diversion.

- 7) In case of any diversion, as mentioned hereinabove, the distance actually covered along the diverted route shall have to be certified by the concerned Distance Certificate Issuing Authority.
- 8) The Transport Contractor shall take all possible precautions to protect the Jute bags to be delivered from any sort of damages during the time of transportation and shall always cover the Jute Bales with tarpaulin sheets in as much as the transport agent shall take all efforts to protect pilferage, if any, during transportation. In this connection transit insurance of full value for the entire jute bags stock during transit are to be done by the Transport Contractor
- 9) In the event of mechanical disorder arising in the truck while at the loading points or enroute, cost of transshipment if any, shall be borne by the Transport Contractor himself.
- 10) No compensation shall be admissible to the Transport Contractor in respect of the detention of trucks in loading/unloading points or any other place(s) during transit.
- 11) The loaded trucks will be unloaded on the same day in the receiving godown point if it arrives by 01.00 p.m., otherwise will be halted and cleared on the next working day. No unloading at godown points of the concerned destination Districts will take place on Sunday & Public Holidays.
- 12) The transport contractor should start loading of Jute Bales within 24 hours from the date of receiving of order for such transportation subject to readiness of the concerned Jute Mill(s) for loading of allotted Jute bag Bales.
- 13) After unloading of consignment of jute bales at district jute godowns, the authorized representative of the transporter shall obtain a certificate from the authorized representative of WBECSC, as to the quantity and quality of the consignment so received, on the body of the road challans.
- 14) The transport contractor shall abide by all the instructions issued by the concerned authorities of WBECSC Ltd. and Food & Supplies Department as well, from time to time.
- 15) In case of necessity, the First Party may extend the tenure of Contract period further upto01 year beyond the stipulated initial period of engagement of 02(two) years as theManagement may deem fit and proper.
- 16) In case any interpretation and/or clarification of any clause and/or clauses of this Tender document are required to be made, interpretation given by the Managing Director of WBECSC shall be final and binding upon the parties.

- 17) In case of any dispute and difference arising by and between the parties the same shall be referred to Arbitration which will be subject to the jurisdiction of the Courts at Kolkata only.
- 18) Around 1.50 Lakh bales of Jute bags may have to be transported in a single year during the period of engagement subject to the actual allotment issued by the Department of Food & Supplies, Govt. of West Bengal corresponding to the supply plan of Govt. of India. Accordingly selected bidder should be capable of placing at least 60 trucks (at least of 50 bales carrying capacity for each truck) to transport 3000 bales of jute bags at a time on a given day.

(4) Financial Model and Payment schedule

- 1) The Transport Contractor shall present his bill in triplicate and B2B format in the prescribed proforma to the WBECSC in physical mode along with following documents:
 - Road Challan/ Consignment Note in Original (Transporter Copy) bearing the certification on the same in regard to the receipt of consignment by representative of WBECSC Ltd. at the unloading points as stated herein.
 - Copy of CRC countersigned by representative posted at Head quarter of WBECSC Ltd.,
 - iii) Copy of the Transport work order issued by the WBECSC for the respective allocation month.
 - iv) Copy of the Distance Certificate issued by concerned RTO/ DCF&S/Executive Engineer (PWD)/ District Engineer Zilla Parishad of the originating or destination district or General Manager (Finance) of WBECSC Ltd.
 - v) Copy of the proof regarding uploading of GST component in the concerned GST portal.
 - vi) Copy of the invoice issued by the Jute Mill for against the respective PCSO.
- 2) The Transport Contractor will be paid the admissible transport bill after deduction of TDS by WBECSC Ltd. tentatively within 01(one) month from the date of receipt of such bill with required documents and necessary certification thereon of respective Authority
- 3) Payment of transportation charges to the transport contractor will be made on the basis of distance certificate issued by the concerned RTO/ DCF&S/Executive Engineer (PWD)/ District Engineer Zilla Parishad of the originating or destination district or General Manager (Finance) of WBECSC Ltd.
- 4) The Transport Contractor will be paid the transport charge according to the rates to be accepted by the competent authority of the WBECSC Ltd.
- 5) The Authority of WBECSC may implement online billing module for payment of such transportation charges in future if the management deems fit in proper. Selected bidder will have to raise bill through such module accordingly as per the terms or requirement of such billing module.

(5.1) Agreement:

The successful bidder shall execute an Agreement in the prescribed form on a non-Judicial stamp paper of value as per law after depositing the Security Deposit Amount, within 07 (seven) days from the date of receipt of the communication of acceptance of the Tender. In the event of failure to execute the agreement, the Earnest Money Deposit shall be forfeited. In addition, the Bidder will be treated as having committed breach of contract and will be liable to pay damages to the Corporation for such breach of contract, besides being black listed. Further, WBECSC Ltd reserves the right to collect the consequential loss, if any, sustained by them on account of re-tender, from the bidder and the bidder is bound to pay the same on demand.

The contract will be governed by the laws of India for the time being in force and all legal proceeding arising out of this Tender document shall be subjected to the exclusive Jurisdiction of the Courts of Kolkata only.

In the event of any dispute or difference of opinion or difficultly arising out this Tender document regarding any stipulation therein or in respect of any matter relating thereto, the same shall be settled between the parties amicably failing which either party will be at liberty to refer the matter to the competent court of law within the jurisdiction of Kolkata for proper adjudication of the matter.

(5.2) Amendment of tender document:

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, the WBECSC Ltd. for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective bidder, may modify the bid document by Amendment. Any such communication shall be posted on website and bidders are requested to visit *www.wbtenders.gov.in* and www.wbecscegovernance.com.

- I. The Transport Contractor should deliver the indented quantity of Jute Bales at the door step of the designated termination/unloading points of the districts concerned and ensure proper signing & certifying on the body of necessary challans by the competent authorities at the designated termination/unloading points.
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At the time of loading, transportation & delivery, if there is any shortage/damage detected, that will be sorted out by the representative of the Transport Contactor.

III. The Managing Director, WBECSC Ltd., also reserves the right to recover any dues from the successful tenderer, which is found, on a later date. Accordingly, the bidder is liable to pay such dues to the Corporation immediately on demand.

(5.4) Penalty Provisions

- a) If a selected transport contractor fails to complete delivery as per work order/indent, their Security Deposit remains liable to be forfeited. Besides, WBECSC Ltd. shall be entitled to recover consequential loss, if any, sustained by the Corporation from the bidder due to the short supply/delivery, irregular supply & untimely supply Jute Bales, or missing of some jute bags from the jute bales, or quantity damaged, owing to noncovering of the same while transporting or any accident occurred, or in other manner what so ever.
- b) In case of non-deposition of Security Deposit within stipulated time and unwillingness after selection as transportation contactor, EMD so deposited will be forfeited.
- c) Any supply /delivery affected beyond valid indented period will be treated as illegal. Delivery should be completed within 03 days from the date of lifting of Jute bags from jute mill point for covering upto 300 KMs and within 10 days beyond 300 KMs. In the event of failure to complete delivery of the bags after lifting from Jute Mills within the aforesaid stipulated period without any reasonable ground, a penalty of Rs. 1000/- per day per truck shall be imposed for each day of delaying delivery. The penalty amount will be adjusted against the claim bill of the concerned transporter in due course.
- d) The Transport Contractor shall not be allowed any transit Loss for transportation and movement of Jute bales and in the event of any shortage either in number of bales or bags or any damage of bags, penalties shall be imposed in the manner stated below.

In the event of any shortage in number of bales or bags, or damage, the Transport Contractor shall be liable to pay a penalty to the tune of 03 (three) times the value of such bale or bag found short or damaged, which will be calculated on the basis of cost of procurement including the incidentals.

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(5.5) Arbitrations

Save and except the specific provisions contained herein above, all disputes and differences arising out of or in any way touching or concerning this agreement whatsoever (except as to any matter the decision of which is expressly provided in the contract) shall be referred to the sole arbitration of any person appointed by the Managing Director, WBECSC LTD. There will be no objection to any such appointment that the person appointed is or was an employee of the State Government. The award of such arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties to this contract. It is a term of this contract that in the event of such arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred, being transferred or vacating his office, dying or being unable to act for any reason, the Managing Director, WBECSC Ltd. at the time of such transfer, vacation or office, death or inability to act, shall appoint another person to act as Arbitrator. Such person shall be entitled to proceed with the reference from the stage at which it was left by his predecessor. It is also a term of this contract that no person other than a person appointed as aforesaid shall act as Arbitrator and if for any reason that is not possible that matter is not to be referred to Arbitration at all.

Provided further that any demand for Arbitration in respect of any claim(s) of the Transport Contractors under the contract shall be in writing and made within one year of the date of completion (expiry of the period) of the contract, or from the date of termination of contract, if it is terminated earlier and where such demand is not made within that period, the claim(s) of the Transport Contractor shall be deemed to have been waived and absolutely barred and the Corporation shall be discharged and released of all liabilities under the contract in respect of those claims. The venue of Arbitration shall be Kolkata and the language shall be in English. The Awarded parties by the arbitrator shall be final and binding upon the parties hereto. **Remuneration of the Arbitrator will be borne equally by Two Parties as per existing norms.**

(5.6) GENERAL:

- I. It is not binding on the part of the Managing Director, WBECSC Ltd., to accept the lowest tender or any tender and he reserves the right to reject or accept all or any tender fully or partly, without assigning any reason thereof. The Managing Director also reserves the right to accept one or more Bids at L1 rate.
- II. The Managing Director reserves the right to relax or waive or amend any of the tender conditions and to reject the tender if any of the conditions enumerated in the tender conditions are violated.
- III. The Transport Contractor shall have to do transit insurance of full value for the entire jute bags stock during transit.

- IV. The bidders should submit documents regarding credential, financial capability and trucks owned by him/ under his disposal, experience in the work of transportation in their official letter head apart from mentioning the same in appendix-4.
- V. The firms/ companies/ proprietorship who have been blacklisted/ a process of blacklisting is going on/ arbitration process is going on in any Govt. Departments/ Agencies/PSUs/Autonomous Bodies, is/ are debarred from participating in the tender process even if they happen to deposit Earnest Money.
- VI. Conditional Tenders shall not be accepted and will be summarily rejected.
- VII. The decision of West Bengal Essential Commodities Supply Corporation Ltd. after evaluation of the documentary evidences the eligibility of bidder shall be final.
- VIII. WBECSC Ltd. reserves the right to reject any/all tender without assigning any reason thereof and the same should not be questioned, whatsoever.

organization, hereinafter referred to as "Transport Agent" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the subject or context of meaning thereof be deemed to include its successors in office, executors, administrators and assigns, of the **SECOND PART**,

WHEREAS WBECSC Ltd. hereby appoints the Transport Agent on the Terms & Conditions herein contained to move the procured jute bales/bags within the district or from one district to another for the KMS and the terms shall take effect from and will be valid up to Payment of transportation charges to the Transport Agent will be made on the basis of distance certificate issued by the RTO/PWD/DCF&S/Executive Engineer/Zilla Parishad of originating and /or terminating Districts or Distance certificates issued by General Manager (Finance), WBECSC Ltd. on the basis of Google Maps.

- Any word or expression or any capitalized term used in this agreement shall, unless otherwise specifically defined this Agreement, have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Tender.
